Subject

The theme of this contest is "Uniting Community and Environment" (either a person or the "hand of man" in relation to the environment).



Images

Submitted images should be 5x7 or 8x10 inch black & white or color prints. Photographs should be unmounted and must be accompanied by a complete entry form.

Submission

Up to three photos may be submitted. Each must be labeled with the photographer's name, address and phone number, along with the title and age category. The four categories are: Grades 1-6, Grades 7-12, College and Community-at-Large. There is a \$1 entry fee for each photo.

Deadlines

Entries can be either mailed to the Urban Ecology Center or dropped off between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday-Saturday. (Address through July 31 is 2808 N. Bartlett Ave., address after August 1 is 1500 E. Park Place.)

Entries also can be dropped off at Mike Crivello's Camera Center, 1700 E. Capitol Dr., in Shorewood, between 9 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday and between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Saturday. Entries must be postmarked no later than Wednesday, August 25.
